UNTER DEN LINDEN

Unter den Linden ("under the linden trees" in English) is a major boulevard in Berlin. The avenue runs East-West and is separated by a pedestrian walkway which is lined by linden trees. A line of linden trees was planted in 1647 as commissioned by Friedrich Wilhelm, seeking to beautify the path that he would take from his castle to the Tiergarten where he would hunt. Many of the trees were damaged and burned during World War II, but were
